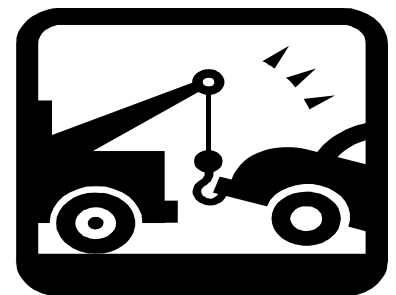

Pick up your trash cans by 6pm Friday.

Recycling Pick-up is Wednesday—put out after 6pm Tuesday evening. Certain holi-
